CHAPTER BENEFITS

Medical ID Bracelets or Necklaces: The Central Ohio Chapter will provide an ID (bracelet, dog tag or necklace, etc.) for all members with a bleeding disorder.

Dental Program: Families without access to dental coverage may be eligible for Delta Dental insurance. Enrollment fee is \$25 per person with a bleeding disorder and \$50 for additional family members in the household with a family maximum of \$200. There is open enrollment year-round and will be accepted based on available funding.

Camp Scholarships: The Central Ohio Chapter offers bleeding disorders camp scholarships to children with bleeding disorders, 6-17 years old and will facilitate transportation when feasible.

Educational Scholarships: Educational scholarships are available to children and adults with a bleeding disorder. Scholarships can be used for tuition, tutoring and books. There is a \$500 limit per person, per year. Checks will be made out directly to the educational institution.

Emergency Financial Assistance: The Central Ohio Chapter offers last resort financial assistance to persons with bleeding disorders for emergency expense needs that arise because of medical complications directly related to their bleeding disorder. Eligible families can request this assistance once per calendar year. Contact your social worker at your HTC with questions or to begin the process.

Counseling: The Central Ohio Chapter offers \$400 per family annually to assist with costs associated with individual or family counseling. These funds can cover co-pays or full costs of the sessions and will be paid directly to the provider. Additional funds may be available upon request.

Invitations to Educational/Social Programs and Workshops: Consumer members (those with an immediate family member with a bleeding disorder living in the household) and board members will be invited to all appropriate programs, workshops and events.

Wellness Programs: The Central Ohio Chapter offers \$400 per family or \$250 annually per individual to be used towards wellness initiatives, such as yoga, swimming lessons, or gym memberships. These programs are open to members and their immediate family members of all ages. We also contract with a yoga instructor who has experience teaching the bleeding disorders community.

Travel Stipend to Regional Trainings/Meetings: The Central Ohio Chapter values our state and neighboring Chapter's programs. When participation is open to our members to attend regional trainings or educational meetings, members can be reimbursed for travel to those meetings up to \$300 per year (we will reimburse at a rate of .50 per mile).
